NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids entitled;

will be received at The Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority (Brick Utilities), 1551 Highway 88 West, Brick, New Jersey, up to **2:00 P.M. prevailing time on March 31, 2010** and publicly opened and read aloud by the Resident Engineer. No bids will be accepted after said prevailing time and day.

**A. The proposed work consists of but is not limited to;**

- 1. Installation of approximately 465 LF of 12-inch C900/RJ Class 150 (DR-18) sanitary sewer main running parallel to an existing sanitary sewer under the Garden State Parkway.**
- 2. Boring and Jacking of approximately 444 LF of 36-inch steel casing for the 12-inch carrier pipe described in the abovementioned work item #1.**
- 3. Installation of approximately 24 LF of 12-inch PVC SDR-35 sanitary sewer pipe in the utility easement section of Evergreen Woods Condominium.**
- 4. Installation of approximately 311 LF of 12-inch PVC SDR-35 sanitary sewer pipe along the utility easement section of the Township of Brick's Park & Ride.**
- 5. Three (3) new epoxy-coated sanitary sewer manholes as shown in the contract drawings.**
- 6. Two (2) new epoxy-coated doghouse manholes, one of which to be provided with two diverter gates as shown in the contract drawings.**

**B. The Contractor shall furnish all materials, tools, equipment, labor, permits, and supervision required to completion of this project.**

**The proposed work is located;**

**Between Evergreen Woods Condominiums, Miranda Court, Brick Township and the Township of Brick Park and Ride, milepost 92.9 on the Garden State Parkway.**

Each prospective bidder will have to provide the appropriate installation references and certifications to the satisfaction of the Owner.

**A Pre-Bid Meeting has been scheduled for March 16, 2010 at 10: 00 A.M.** at Brick Utilities Main Conference Room in the Administration Building at aforementioned address. Following the Pre-Bid Meeting, all interested parties will be escorted to the project location for a site inspection.

Bids must be submitted on forms prepared by the Brick Utilities. All bids must be enclosed in sealed, specially addressed envelope bearing on the outside the name and address of the bidder and work bid upon. All envelopes should be sent to the attention of the Engineering Department.

**Specifications may be obtained by bona fide bidders upon application at the office of Brick Utilities, 1551 Highway 88 West, Brick, NJ 08724, on or after March 3, 2010,** upon payment of **\$100.00** per set. Checks should be made payable to the order of The Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority, shall be non-refundable and no refunds will be made for return of complete or partial contract documents.

Each bid must be accompanied by a Bid Bond or Certified Check for an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the bid or a maximum of \$20,000.00; such certification to be without condition or qualification, and the check made payable to The Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority. Each bid must also be accompanied by an agreement to become surety, properly executed by a surety company authorized to do business in the State of New Jersey and which agreement shall be attached to the proposal.

All bidders shall be required to comply with the requirements of Chapter 127, P.L 1975, requiring each bidder and each subcontractor to formulate and submit to the proper authorized representative of the State of New Jersey an affirmative action program of equal opportunity which guarantees minorities employment in all categories.

If a bidder is a corporation or a partnership, the bidder, in conformance with Chapter 33, P.L. 1977, shall submit with his bid a statement setting forth the names and addresses of all stockholders who own a ten percent (10%) or greater interest in the firm.

This contract or subcontract is expected to be funded in part with funds from the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Trust. Neither the State of New Jersey, the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Trust nor any of their departments, agencies or employees is, or will be, a party to this contract or subcontract or any lower tier contract or subcontract. This contract or subcontract is subject to the provisions of 7:22-3, 4, 5, 9 and 10. The successful Bidder will be required to comply with N.J.A.C. 7:22-3.1 et. seq., 4.1 et. seq., and 5.1 et. seq. The successful Bidder will be required to comply with N.J.A.C. 7:22-9.1 et. seq. for the participation of small business enterprises owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged

individuals (SEDs). The Contractor and all subcontractors will be required to comply with the SED Utilization Plan developed by Brick Utilities for fulfilling SED requirements.

The Project shall conform to the Local Public Contract Law, P.L. 1971, Chapter 198, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et. seq. The bid receipt date will be at least 10 days after the advertisement date. As required by N.J.S.A.40A:11-23(c) addenda notices will be provided no less than seven days prior to the bid receipt deadline.

Brick Utilities reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any and all bids, if, it is in the public interest to do so.
