will be received at The Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority (Brick Utilities), 1551 Highway 88 West, Brick, New Jersey, up to **2:00 P.M., prevailing time Thursday, February 23, 2012**, and publicly opened and read aloud by the Resident Engineer. No bids will be accepted after said prevailing time and day.

The proposed work consists of but is not limited to;

The proposed work consists of but is not limited to the rehabilitation of approximately 3,860 LF of existing eight (8”) inch diameter A.C.P. sanitary sewer line, 1,124 LF of ten (10”) inch diameter A.C.P. sanitary sewer line, 2,387 LF of existing twelve (12”) inch diameter A.C.P. sanitary sewer line, by using the “Light Stream” ultra-violet light cured-in-place pipeline reconstruction method. The proposed work also consists of but is not limited to the rehabilitation of approximately 1,616 LF of existing four (4”) inch diameter A.C.P./PVC sanitary sewer lateral line by using the “flex-liner” cured-in-place pipeline reconstruction method. The proposed work consists of but is not limited to the rehabilitation of 84 existing active sewer service connections utilizing the “Lateral Connection Repair – Cap” units using the “Epros” LCR liner system.

The proposed work is located on Brick Boulevard, Drum Point Road Sports Complex, Rolling Hills Drive, Hill Drive, Albermarle Road, Neptune Circle, Arlene Ct., Kathy Ct., Debbie Drive, Briar Mills Easement, and Mantoloking Road all located within Brick Township, Ocean County, New Jersey.

Each prospective bidder will have to provide the appropriate installation references and certifications to the satisfaction of the Owner.

A Pre-Bid Meeting has been scheduled for 10:00 A.M., prevailing time Tuesday, January 31, 2012 at the Brick Utilities Main Conference Room in the Administration Building at aforementioned address. Following the Pre-Bid Meeting, all interested parties will be escorted to the project location for a site inspection.

Bids must be submitted on forms prepared by Brick Utilities. All bids must be enclosed in sealed, specially addressed envelope bearing on the outside the name and address of the bidder and work bid upon. All envelopes should be sent to the attention of the Engineering Department.

Specifications may be obtained by bona fide bidders upon application at the office of The Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority, 1551 Highway 88 West, Brick, NJ 08724, on or after **Thursday, January 19, 2012**, upon payment of **\$100.00 per set**. Checks should be made payable to the order of The Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority, shall be non-refundable and no refunds will be made for return of complete or partial contract documents.

Each bid must be accompanied by a Bid Bond or Certified Check for an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the bid or a maximum of \$20,000.00; such certification to be without condition or qualification, and the check made payable to The Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority. Each bid must also be accompanied by an agreement to become surety, properly executed by a surety company authorized to do business in the State of New Jersey and which agreement shall be attached to the proposal.

All bidders shall be required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27, requiring each bidder and each subcontractor to formulate and submit to the proper authorized representative of the State of New Jersey an affirmative action program of equal opportunity which guarantees minorities employment in all categories.

If a bidder is a corporation or a partnership, the bidder, in conformance with Chapter 33, P.L. 1977, shall submit with his bid a statement setting forth the names and addresses of all stockholders who own a ten percent (10%) or greater interest in the firm.

This contract or subcontract is expected to be funded in part with funds from the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Trust. Neither the State of New Jersey, the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Trust nor any of their departments, agencies or employees is, or will be, a party to this contract or subcontract or any lower tier contract or subcontract. This contract or subcontract is subject to the provisions of N.J.A.C. 7:22-3, 4, 5, 9 and 10.

The successful Bidder will be required to comply with N.J.A.C. 7:22-9.1 et. seq. for the participation of small business enterprises owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals (SEDs). The Contractor and all subcontractors will be required to comply with the SED Utilization Plan developed by Brick Utilities for fulfilling SED requirements.

The Project shall conform to the Local Public Contract Law, P.L. 1971, Chapter 198, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et. seq. The bid receipt date will be at least ten (10) days after the advertisement date; addenda notices will be provided no less than seven (7) days prior to the bid receipt deadline.

Brick Utilities reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any and all bids, if, it is in the public interest to do so.
